Participation in the Scheme for 2026 is \$195-00. We offer prepayment of the fees and payments can commence immediately. Payments can be made by Cash, Cheque Eftpos, Direct Deposit or if you are in receipt of any Centrelink payments including Abstudy we can set up Centrepay for you.
