The Student Resource Scheme provides textbooks, equipment and resources to members throughout the school year.

Upon joining, the scheme provides each participant with all the required textbooks and/or class sets for each subject selected; workbooks for Maths, Science and English; reproduced class materials which complement or substitute for textbooks; a wider range of textbooks, where a single text is insufficient; audio and visual tapes; teacher prepared handouts; access to some computer resources; novels to be read and access to class sets of books; subject materials and many other school resources throughout the school year, as well as a Student ID card.

Participation in the Scheme for 2026 is \$195-00. We offer prepayment of the fees and payments can commence immediately. Payments can be made by Cash, Cheque Eftpos, Direct Deposit or if you are in receipt of any Centrelink payments including Abstudy we can set up Centrepay for you. Please see the staff in the Office.

Students need to provide their own stationery items, cooking materials and some protective clothing as detailed in the separate *Stationery List*.
